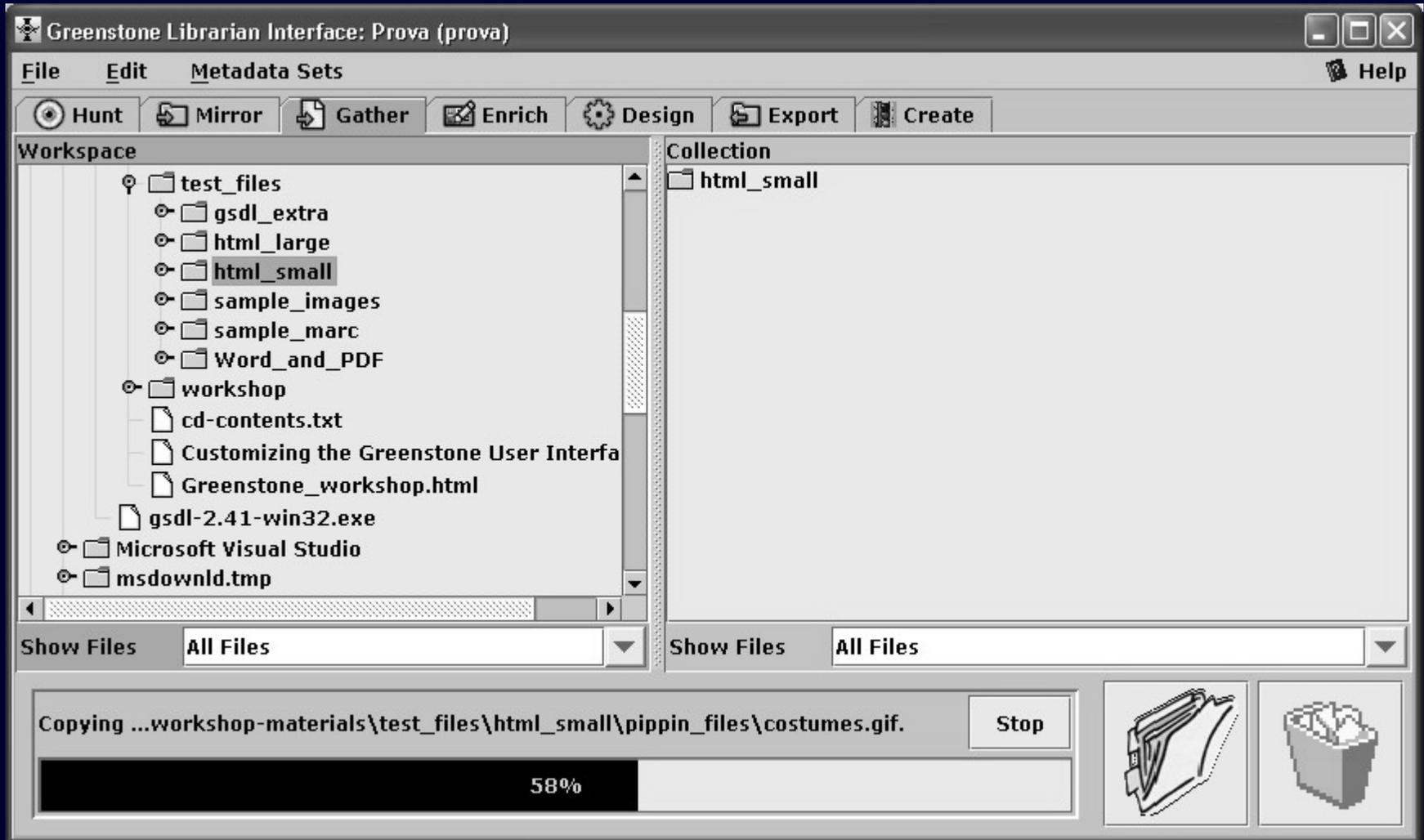

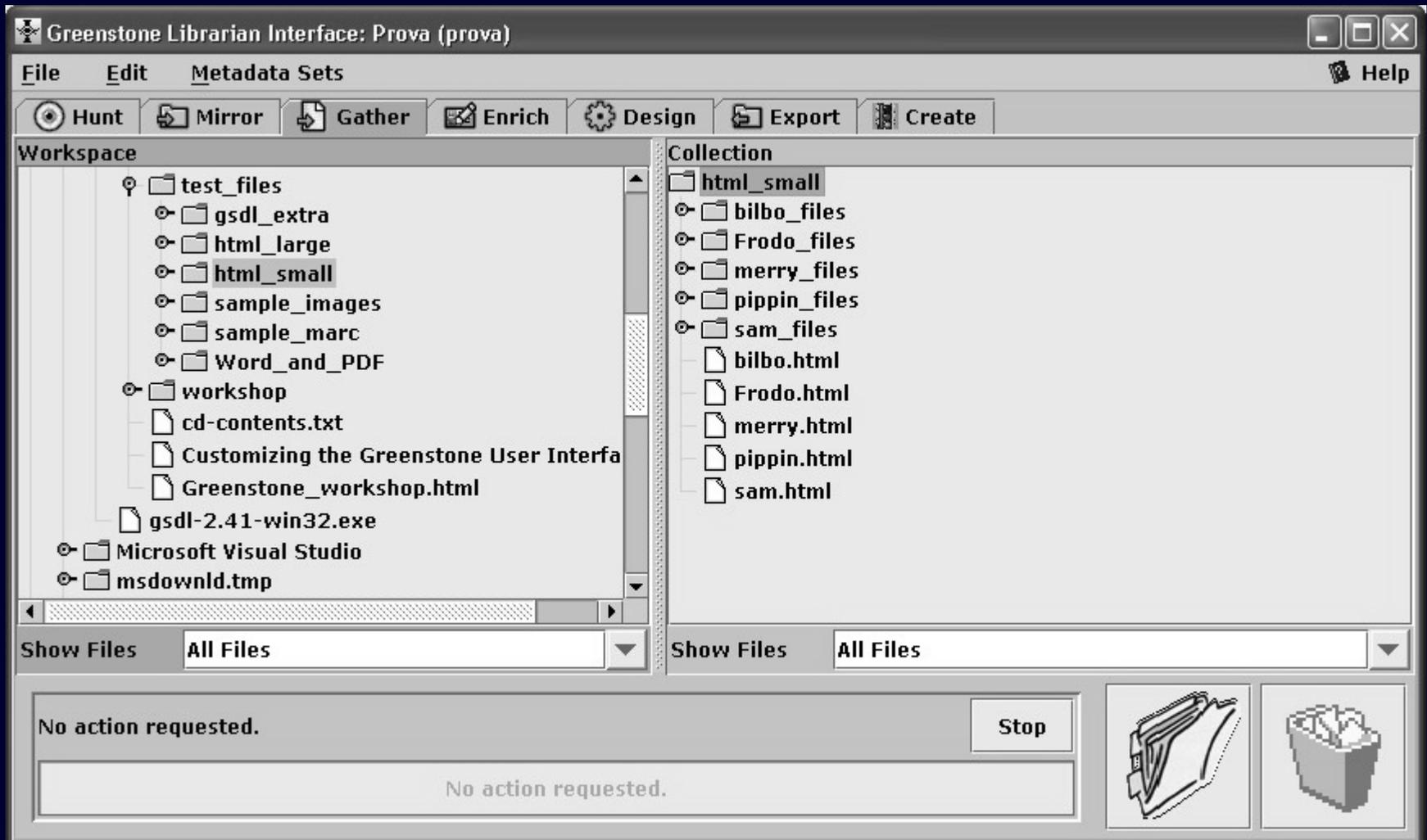

How to find information in the Prova collection

There are 3 ways to find information in this collection:

- search for particular words
- access publications by title
- access publications by filename

You can *search for particular words* that appear in the text from the "search" page. This is the first page that comes up when you begin, and can be reached from other pages by pressing the *search* button.

You can *access publications by title* by pressing the *titles a-z* button. This brings up a list of books in alphabetic order.

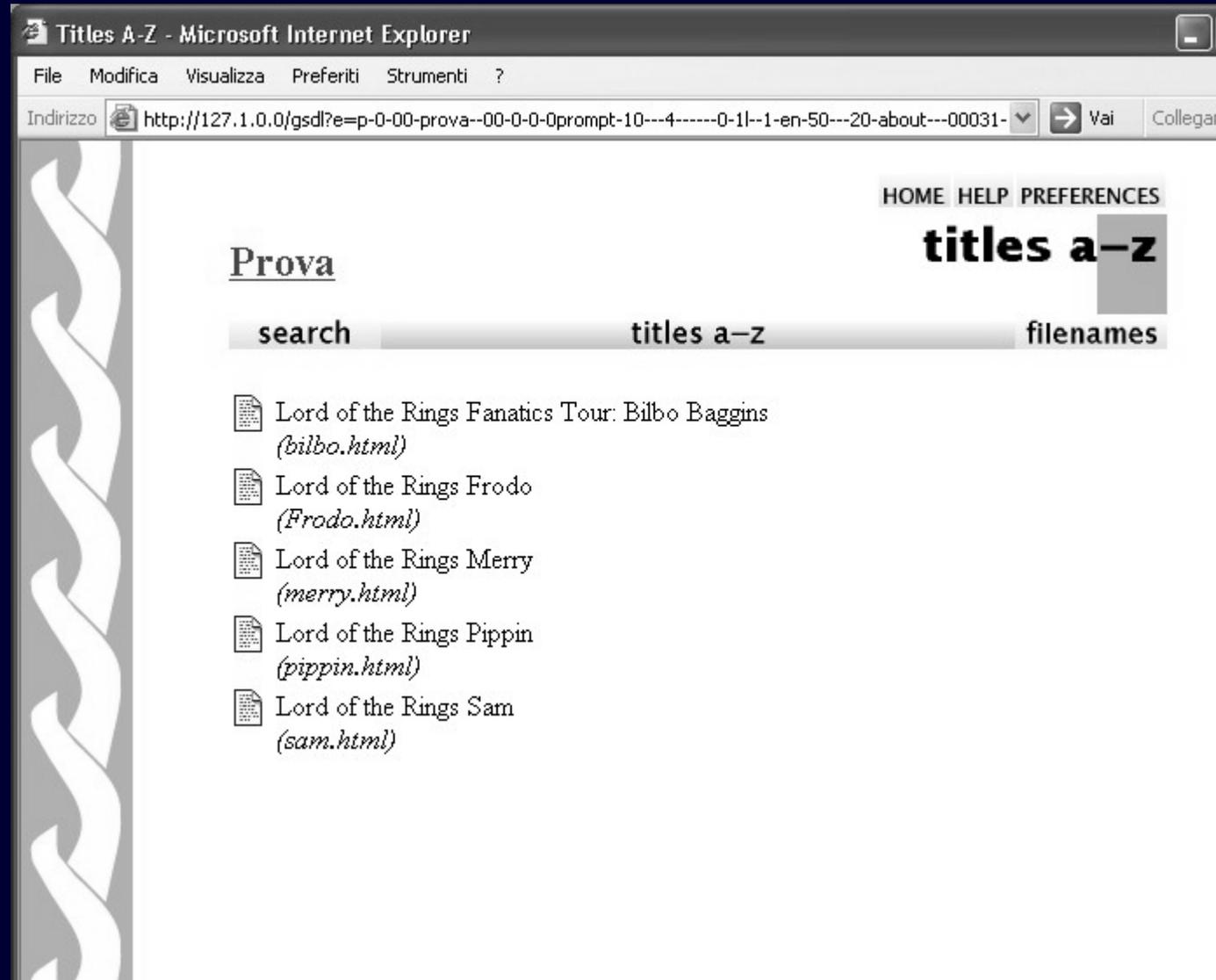
You can *access publications by filename* by pressing the *filenames* button. This brings up a list of entries, sorted by original filename.

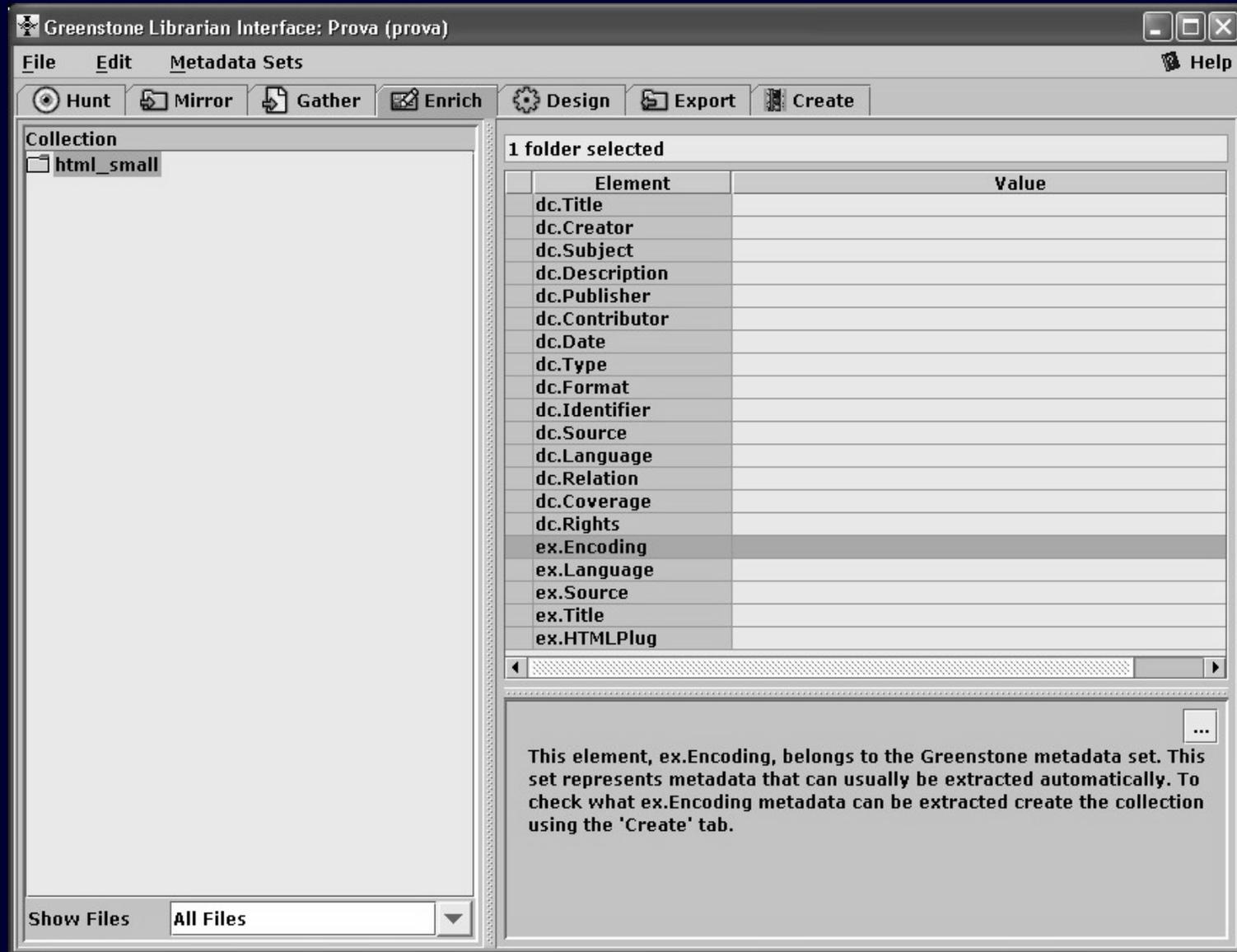

- Si usa la Librarian Interface per inserire valori per i metadati Title, Creator e Description
- Si associa un Title diverso ad ogni immagine, mentre si associa lo stesso Creator a tutte le immagini
- Si modificano le modalità di visualizzazione dei metadati inseriti (funzione Format Feature)

- Si configura il plug-in che opera sulle immagini, in modo da generare dei thumbnail più piccoli
- Viene creato un indice di ricerca sulle “description”
- **Esercizio**
 - Analogamente a quanto fatto nell’esercitazione per Title, Creator e Description, si richiede di associare una data ad alcune immagini ed a creare un classificatore che visualizzi i documenti in base alla data
 - [Nel panel Design si deve selezionare la sezione Browsing Classifiers ed aggiungere un classificatore di tipo DateList per il metadato dc.Date]
 - Viene inoltre richiesto di creare un indice di ricerca sulla data
